It is anticipated that the FDA will approve the Pfizer vaccine for 12 to 15 year olds in the coming days. The Newtown School District has been invited to give interested families the opportunity to pre register their 12 to 15 year old students for the Pfizer vaccine, to be given at the New Milford Health Department vaccine clinic once approval is finalized. Students who are pre registered will be notified when the vaccine is approved and will receive an email to let them know when they can proceed with making an appointment. This clinic is being organized by Lisa Morrissey, the well respected Health Director for the Town of New Milford.
