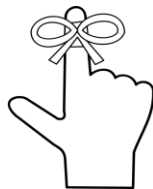


## REMINDER



The guidelines from CT Department of Health advise testing for anyone who develops symptoms suggestive of COVID 19, regardless of vaccine status. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the Covid virus.

**Key symptoms include fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste/smell. Any ONE of these symptoms is a reason to stay home and be tested.**

If someone has **any combination of nonspecific symptoms such as headache, sore throat, unusual fatigue, runny nose, muscle aches, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea, please stay home and get COVID tested.**

Please report positive test results to your school nurse as soon as possible so contact tracing can be done.
