### **LEARNING FOCUS**

**LANGUAGE ARTS** - Introduced letter li, letter li word wall and writing practice, stickers on li, Journal (topic- Castle Hill Field trip continued). Finger play "5 Little Pumpkins".

**RELIGION**- The children are continuing to explore the signs of Fall God has blessed us with and all of the changes it brings.

**MATH**- Sorting/classifying Halloween erasers, AB patterning using black/orange plastic spiders, one-one correspondence and recognition of #1 &2.

**SCIENCE** - We continued to discuss the Life cycle of a pumpkin (seeds, vines, flowers, pumpkins), Engaged in an experiment "sink or float" using a pumpkin. Children made predictions and results were recorded.
