LEARNING FOCUS

LANGUAGE ARTS - Letter review (T,L,I), Nursery Rhyme “Little Miss Muffet”, Story response and retell “Don't Let the Pigeon Drive the Bus!” Journaling (topic- Halloween).

RELIGION- The children listened to stories about Saints and their good deeds for All Saints Day!

MATH- Counting spider cards #1-10, plastic spiders and one-to-one correspondence #1-5, **ABB** patterning using bats, spiders, and ghost erasers.
