



March Bookmark Contest

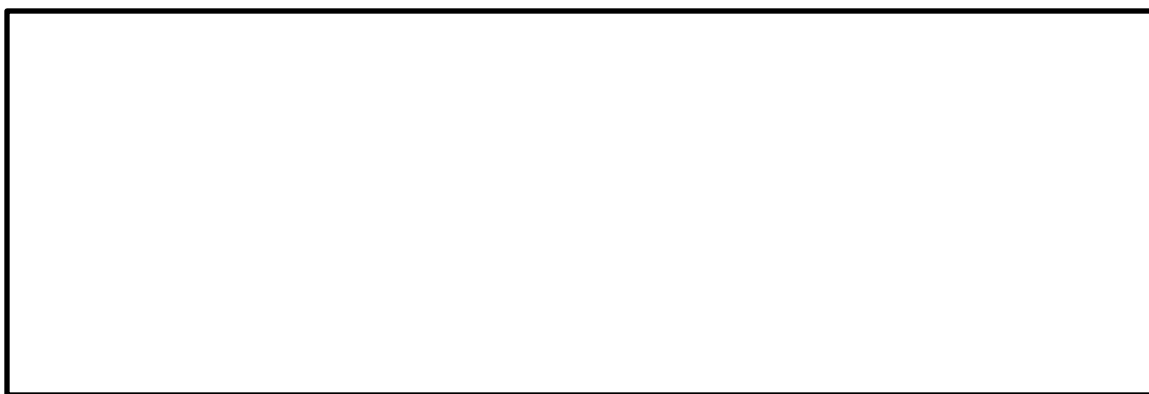
Create a colorful bookmark using the theme of

One elementary and one middle school winner will be chosen for March's virtue of Tranquility:

TRANQUILITY

Keep yourself from reacting poorly to others. People are not perfect and the world is not fair. Lean to deal with both despite imperfections. Be patient.



Winning entries will be professionally printed and distributed as bookmarks to students in grades K-5. For grades 6-8, the winning entries will be printed as a poster and placed on display in the middle school hallways. *All middle school monthly winners will be entered into a contest to paint the rock in May*

Contest Rules:

- Artist must be a current BFA student.
- Entries must be your own creative idea and artwork and should reflect what the selected virtue means to you.
- Entries must include the name of the selected virtue(s) on the face of the bookmark.
- Bookmarks should measure 2 inches by 6 inches and be single sided only.
- The bookmark may be drawn vertically or horizontally.
- You may submit as many entries as you like.
- Bookmark entries will not be returned, so please keep a copy for yourself.
- By submitting a contest entry, you are acknowledging permission for the PTO to use and reproduce your entry's image.

All entries are to be submitted to the collection box
in the Shelly Dana Library on or before March 7, 2019.
