"Race to Read"® starts on March 27 and ends on May 5

(completed BINGO sheets need to include activities that are accomplished **AFTER** March 27 and not before the start of the program)

Your student will have the opportunity to earn a ticket for themselves and one adult (\$65 value) to the season-opening event at Bandimere Speedway—the NAPA Auto Parts "Night of Fire & Thunder", scheduled for Saturday, May 20.

When the BINGO is complete (and signed by you), please mail, email, fax or drop off at our offices **BOTH** pages of the completed BINGO (contact information below) before the May 5th deadline. A ticket/wristband will be mailed to your student (good for child and one adult) for free entry to the event. Ticket/wristbands will be mailed to students the week of May 8th.

Students who complete the BINGO and receive a ticket to the event on May 20, will also be eligible to pick up a prize goodie bag at the event. Goodie bag tent will be open from 3pm until 8pm and will be located on the west side of the staging lanes near the Novus Glass Tech Building (look for "Race to Read" banners). If unable to be at the "Night of Fire & Thunder" on May 20, stop by our offices located at the Speedway during the summer months with your student's unused ticket/wristband to pick up a goodie bag. 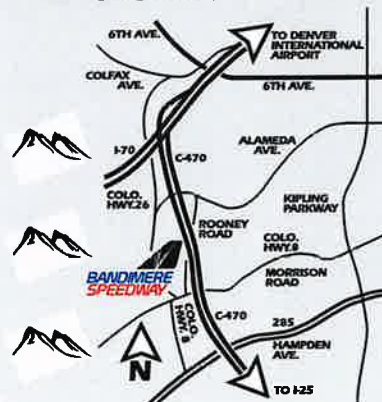
