- **Wish List Drive (Collected Dec. 11 through Jan. 12th)**
 - A box will be placed in the lobby for students to drop off donations
 - Items we are collecting:
 - **Cleaning Supplies**
 - Paper Towels
 - Lysol Disinfectant Spray
 - Disinfectant Wipes
 - Toilet Bowl Cleaner
 - Glass Cleaner
 - **Kitchen**
 - Aluminum Foil
 - Zip Lock Bags
 - Powder Dishwasher Detergent
 - Food Containers for Leftovers
 - Trash Bags – 4 Gallon, 13 Gallon & 33 Gallon capacities
- **Soda Can Pop-tabs collection (Collected Dec. 11 through Feb. 23)**
