This session is for incoming 6th-8th grade EXPERIENCED players who have played a volleyball season either with BFA or outside of BFA. To qualify for this session, you need to know the rules of the game, and possess basic consistent skills of passing, setting, hitting and serving. This session focus on increased individual skill level and level of team play, as well as playing specific positions and a 6-2 offense.
