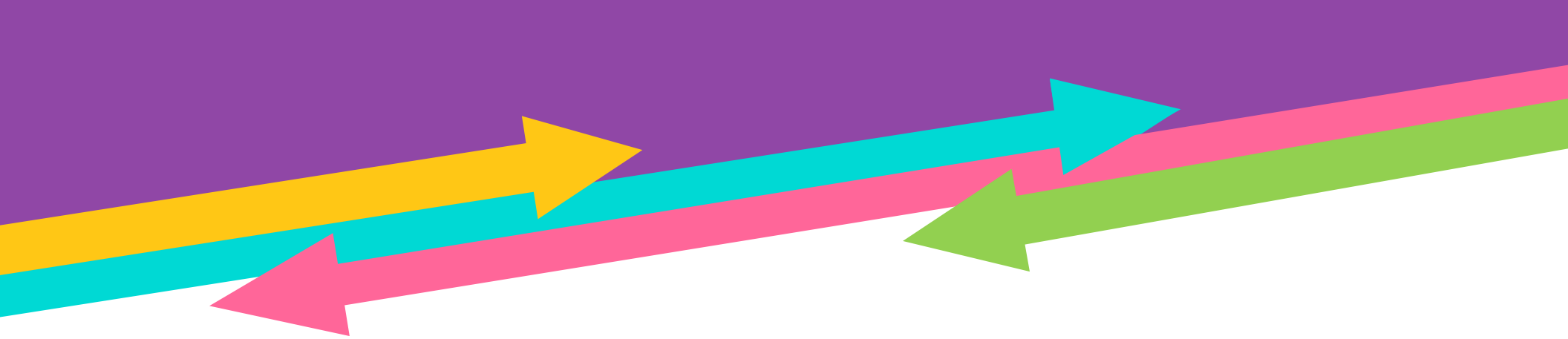




## ABOUT THE EVENT

### Who should attend?

Parents and their youth, ages 14-21, with a diagnosis of epilepsy/seizure disorder who have a desire to transition into the next stages of young adulthood.

### What will you do?

Parents and youth will participate in skill building sessions and workshops throughout the weekend. Participants will learn the skills needed to effectively transition to the next stages of life. Families will develop goals that create a vision for a successful life as a young adult whether you are interested in higher education or plan to go to work after high school. ### What is transition?

Transition is the process of moving youths into adulthood and can include moving from pediatric to adult health care, post-secondary schooling options, independent living, employment, self-advocacy, and more.

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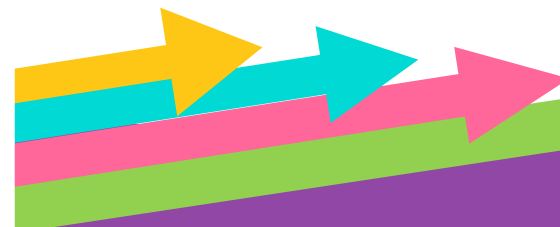
