Paul Schulenburg




Paul fell in love with Cape Cod when he was about 5 years old. He studied fine art and commercial art many years ago. Paul graduated from Boston University School of Fine Arts where he received his educational foundation for the fundamentals of classical art training: anatomy, form, color composition and draftsmanship. He received his degree in 1979.

He began his career in the 80's doing concept illustrations. He received a Gold Medal from the National Scholastic Art Awards program in 1975.

In the 1980's and 90s he wrote for various publications and received many awards for his work and has appeared and been published worldwide. Former clients include Digital, Cigna, and Fidelity. He has sold many of his illustrations he made years ago to stock companies in New York who resold them to other companies 30 or 40 times. He was able to purchase his first home in Brewster.

He has been featured twice in "Art Collectors of America" Magazine, has numerous articles in the Cape Cod Annual discussing his Monday and Wednesday night Painters group. He has had shows all over the Cape including The Hopper House Museum, twice with solo shows at the Cape Cod Museum of Art, many group exhibitions at CCMA, Provincetown Art Association and Museum, and the Cahoon Museum of American Art. He invites people to paint with his group via Zoom, and has people join from all over the world.



He has been awarded a one month residency at the Fine Art Work Center in Provincetown. He is a member of the Oil Painters of America, American Impressionist Society, and the Salmagundi Club in New York.

We have been lucky to have him Demo for us twice before since I have been Demo chairperson. Paul is the type of communicator, talent and gentleman from whom you could learn something new from every time he presents!
