2025 Park Renovations

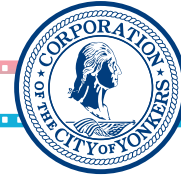

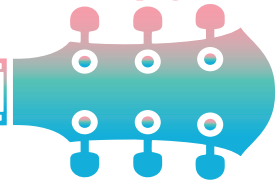
10TH Annual Summer Film & Concert Series
