TOPIC

Adult support and further education options available to students after they exit from high school or adult transition programs. Whether a student is working towards a diploma or a certificate of completion, this event will feature transition information from which ALL students may benefit.

FORMAT

The first 45 minutes of the event will feature speakers from the Department of Rehabilitation (DOR), San Diego Regional Center (SDRC), and the State Council on Developmental Disabilities (SCDD). DOR and SDRC will describe their roles and services as they pertain to Transition Age Youth and SCDD will provide information regarding Regional Center's Self-Determination Program.

The remainder of the event will feature a breakout-style opportunity for families and students to meet representatives from multiple agencies and programs. Recognizing that not all individuals may be (or choose to be) clients of DOR or SDRC, this event will also host agencies and programs that provide a broad range of post-secondary options to ALL individuals.

Agencies, programs and services represented will include: Workforce Development; San Diego Workforce Partnership funded career centers; Supported Employment; Education and Career Technical Training; Academic Support; Paid Trade Internships; Job development and Coaching; SDRC Paid Internship Program; Vocational & Training Services; Job Search and Placement; Independent Living; Behavioral Day Program; Supported Living; Tailored Day Service; Mobility Training; Community Based Day Program; Disability Support; SSI and SSDI: planning assistance and work incentives;
