

DAY BY DAY, AS THEY SPENT MUCH TIME TOGETHER... (ACTS 2:46A)

This is an exciting time in the life of the church. We have stepped out in faith and followed the Lord on an adventure. God is doing new things. We are merely months away from the end of our building project and moving into the new Ministry Center on LA Grant Parkway.

This is a major moment in the life of our congregation. That's why, in October, we will be having a church-wide worship and stewardship emphasis called Life Together. During this time, we will consider how the early church lived their life together after Jesus' resurrection, and we will ask you to make a financial commitment to our 2023 Ministry Budget.

For 2023, as you are able, we encourage all members and friends to increase their Annual Giving to support the Ministry Budget for the ongoing and expanding ministries of the church in a new facility, reaching out to this growing community. This is our time to step up and grow in all that we're doing. As we seek to be faithful in all the new things God is doing, our Ministry Budget is growing significantly. It's such a big step forward for us, but Jesus teaches us to risk everything that God entrusts to us. The Kingdom of God is risky business (Matthew 25:14-30).

A packet with a pledge card has been mailed (or could be picked up at the Welcome Center). We will have the opportunity to make personal commitments of our offerings to God through the church in the coming year. We will highlight the ministries to be funded by our commitments during a special Celebration Sunday Worship and Dinner on October 23. That Sunday we won't meet at our interim gathering space (South Middle School) and instead we will meet at Country Lane Lodge (29300 Prospect Circle, Adel). If you're unable to join us that Sunday, you will have an opportunity to return your commitment the following Sunday, October 30 back at the school where we will also consecrate the commitment cards. You're also welcome to mail it to the church office or make your commitment directly in the Realm App.

Please join us in October! The mission and ministry of our church is dependent upon the grace of God and the support of God's people through your prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness. Thank you for your generosity and commitment to the ministry of our congregation!

MEET DREW KLEIN!

Hello, I am Drew Klein, the new Director of Discipleship. A little background about me: I was born in Atlanta, Georgia, and I have always been in the church. Both my parents have always been heavily involved in all areas of the church. At the age of nine, I made the suggestion we move to Iowa in hopes of being closer to family. So we did! We moved up to Waterloo, Iowa where I attended grade school and high school. I was involved in the youth group at First United Methodist Cedar Falls. When I was a senior, I helped plan and run our Wednesday youth service.

After graduating high school, I decided to stick close to home and go to UNI for school. At UNI I was involved with the campus ministry called BASIC. Through BASIC I grew in my faith exponentially and made many deep relationships. I also volunteered with the youth program at one of the local churches where I led a group of students all the way from 7th grade through their senior year of high school. While at UNI I obtained my degree in Long Term Care Administration, which allowed me to become the administrator of nursing care facilities.

Post-graduation I worked in a few long term care facilities, helping to manage them. With the last company I was an administrator for, I worked many short term assignments in towns like Ottumwa, Forest City, Villisca, and even a town called Wagner in South Dakota. I finally decided to take on a facility in Postville, Iowa for a more permanent assignment. After many trying months of the pandemic, I decided I would leave the nursing home world and try to figure out what I wanted to be when I grew up. More recently, while I was trying to figure that out, I worked for Veridian Credit Union.

I have been attending a summer camp called Summer Games University since I was in 6th grade. During my years there, I met Pastor John and Mara. While at the camp this year I was approached by several people who asked why I was not doing ministry full time. I did not have an answer for them. I started praying and talking with others and came to the realization that I was being called outside of just volunteering my time for God. I was being called to serve God and his people within my professional life as well.

Then Pastor John reached out to me about this position, and that is how I got here. I am so excited to see what God has planned for this church, myself, and these ministries I have been called to lead. I hope to make long lasting connections with all who attend Waukee United Methodist, and I pray that God may use me to bless this community.
