Welcome to the 2023 FROG International Rally!

We hope you'll have a wonderful time, and that you'll take advantage of the opportunities to make new friendships and renew existing ones; enjoy great meals, entertainment, and hospitality; learn about your RV and ways of enjoying and caring for it; experience informative tours of Amish area attractions; and much more.

<u>Please wear your nametag in its green wallet while on the grounds and on any tours.</u> Your nametag is your ticket to all events, as well as to help other members get acquainted with you. If you have children or grandchildren with you, please be sure they are wearing their nametags as well. FOR YOUNG CHILDREN, please write your name and phone number on the back of their nametags so that we can contact you in case they become separated from you.

<u>Meals</u> will be served in Building A, the largest building on the fairgrounds, located just west of the RV display and the stage lawn. Breakfast will be served Monday through Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. (Service Techs will be in for breakfast at 7:00. Please wait until 7:30 to arrive so that they can finish and report for the day's service activities.) Dinner will be served on Sunday, Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Doors open at 5:00, serving lines open at 5:30.

For breakfast, please feel free to go directly to the serving lines when you enter the building. For dinner, please come in and have a seat. We will call tables by section to go through the serving lines in order to reduce time standing in line. At all meals please take one serving, then feel free to return once everyone has been served.

<u>Concerts on the Lawn</u> are scheduled for Wednesday and Friday evening, weather permitting. Please bring a lawn chair and join in the fun! In case of inclement weather, we'll move into Building A.

<u>Vendors</u> are located Buildings E and F, the two buildings adjacent to Building A, and in several nearby outdoor locations. Vendor areas will be open Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. In addition to the great products, great deals, and great information that they provide, many of the vendors will be doing prize drawings each day, so be sure to go back on a regular basis to see if you're a winner!

The **FROG Rally Office** is in Building E, the vendor building nearer Building A. Lost and found is located there, as are general information about the FROG Rally and the area, postings about people who want to buy or sell tour tickets, and more.

The <u>Rally Service Center</u> is in the Ag Hall, corner of Oak and Dahlia, just east of the Elkhart County Community Center. If you have requested service on your RV, you must check in at the Service Center. The Service Center is open from 9 to 4 on Monday through Wednesday, and from 9 to 3 on Thursday. It will be open on Friday if needed. Please be sure you have your campsite number from the orange tag that you will receive when you park, and that you provide a phone number where you can be reached. Enjoy the Rally events while you're waiting for a service tech to call and come to your RV. You will also be asked if you want to authorize the service techs to enter and work on your RV if you are not there. Remember that animals must be crated or removed from the RV if the service team is going to be inside to prevent injury or accidental escape.

The Forest River RV display will be open Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Friday from 9:00 a.m. to noon.

Golf cart "limo" shuttles, nicknamed the <u>Pad Hopper Express</u>, will be available every day throughout the fairgrounds. These are generally 6-passenger carts and will be identified with a Pad Hopper sign. They are frequently located near the vendor buildings and the seminar areas. Just flag one down as needed.

<u>Alcohol</u> may be consumed at campsites or at dinner by those of legal age. Please do not consume alcohol at other locations, including while in or on a golf cart or any other vehicle. Please be considerate and respectful of others around your campsite.

No ground fires or other wood fires are allowed. Propane campfire containers are allowed.

<u>Please do not discharge wastewater onto the ground.</u> If you do not have a sewer site, you will be able to obtain a free pump-out on Wednesday or Thursday. BE SURE TO HAVE YOUR GREEN TAG attached to the front of the unit and visible to the driver as the truck comes by. If your discharge valves are inside a compartment, PLEASE HAVE THE COMPARTMENT OPEN. Please note the number of valves on your green tag if you have more than two.

<u>Bus Tours:</u> All bus tours will load on the front parking lot of the Elkhart County Community Center, where you checked in with parking when you arrived. PLEASE BE THERE AT THE DESIGNATED TIME ON THE SCHEDULE. We cannot hold buses for late arrivals. Tours will travel on air-conditioned Cardinal buses. We'll have volunteers at each bus to make sure you're on the right bus.

If you have reservations on one of the tours and decide not to go, or if you are hoping to get on one of those tours, you can post a note at the FROG Rally Office in the vendor area. Any transactions are between the buyer and the seller. FROG will not be buying back or refunding any tours in Goshen.

Seminars: We have over 70 seminars scheduled throughout the week.

- Seminar Areas 1-4 are in the Elkhart County Community Center, the large building where you registered. Use the entrances on the back side, facing the fair-grounds. Signs mark the Seminar Areas, starting with Seminar Area 1 on the left.
- A few seminars or demonstrations will be in other areas. These are noted on the agenda, along with the description of each event.
