**LEARN MORE ABOUT THE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM TODAY!**

The Westchester-Fairfield Joint Electrical Apprenticeship Training Committee (WFJEATC) will conduct a recruitment from September 15, 2020 – September 14, 2021 for 15 electrical apprentices.

The Westchester Apprentice Program is a 5 ½ year program and consists of 9,000 hours of on-the-job training while working for affiliated contractors in Westchester County or western Fairfield County, Connecticut. Apprentices work during the day and attend vocational school and college two nights a week in White Plains.

The current wages are as follows:

- \$13 per hour for first year apprentices
- \$15 per hour for second year apprentices
- \$17 per hour for third year apprentices
- \$19 per hour for fourth year apprentice
- \$23 per hour for the first 12 months of the fifth period.
- \$26.50 per hour for the last 6 months of the fifth period.
- Journeypersons currently make \$52.75 per hour.

Apprentices get at least 900 hours of classroom training, for which there is no fee. Apprentices are also required to attend Empire State College (ESC), which is part of SUNY, one night a week in White Plains. All apprentices receive an Associate Degree after 4 years. ESC tuition is paid by the apprentice program.
