A total of four virtual field trips are offered throughout the fall of 2020, with three different types of trips available. Each trip will be guided by farmers and beef experts and will transport students live to a cow-calf farm, a seedstock farm and into a meat science laboratory, where animals are harvested and fabricated into edible cuts. These trips share how beef cattle are raised, cared for and provided in Ohio. Students will also be able to chat directly with farmers and experts during live Q&A sessions.

Each trip is also recorded so that classrooms or students at home not able to participate in the live virtual field trips can watch a trip on-demand.
