NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

- **Educator must currently teach insurance or financial literacy in the classroom and provide students with effective and innovative instruction. Instruction can be part of any course such as family and consumer science, business, economics, mathematics, personal finance, social studies or related courses.**
- **Educator must teach in Ohio vocational or high school.**
- **Nomination must be submitted by February 12, 2021.**

Anyone—including educators (nominating themselves or other teachers), principals or administrators, students, insurance professionals and consumers—can make a nomination. The awardee will be announced in May 2021.

AWARDS

- **\$1,000 award to the educator**
- **\$500 award to the educator's school**
- **Recognition during our Annual Meeting and a plaque**
- **Reimbursement of course fees (up to \$500) for successfully completing a future graduate-credit workshop or course designed for high school teachers. Subjects covered must include some insurance or financial literacy topics.**

JUDGING CRITERIA

Judging will be based on items such as:

- **Insurance subjects taught**
- **Demonstration of varied approaches to student needs and learning styles**
- **Creativity in teaching methods**

A panel of judges who represent Ohio's insurance industry will select the awardee.

**OII reserves the right to add or eliminate awards when, in its judgment, either the number or quality of entries warrants such action. The decision of the OII will be final. Previous awardees are ineligible. OII employees and judging committee members are excluded from nominating a candidate. Judging committee members may not vote on or influence the selection of an educator who teaches at a school attended by an OII employee's or judge's children.*

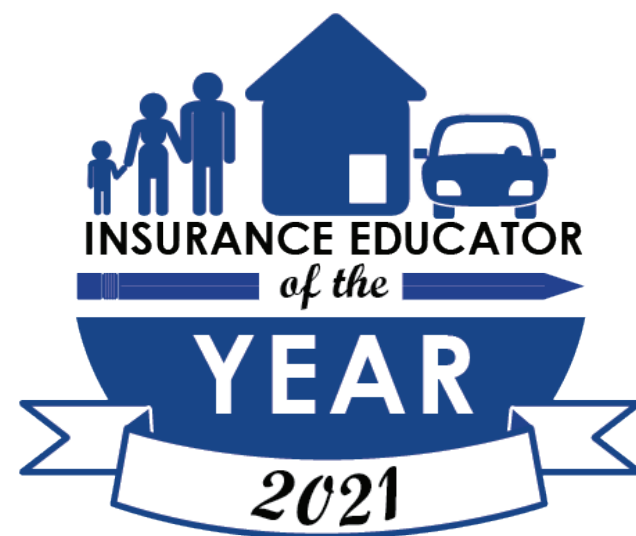

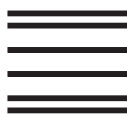
