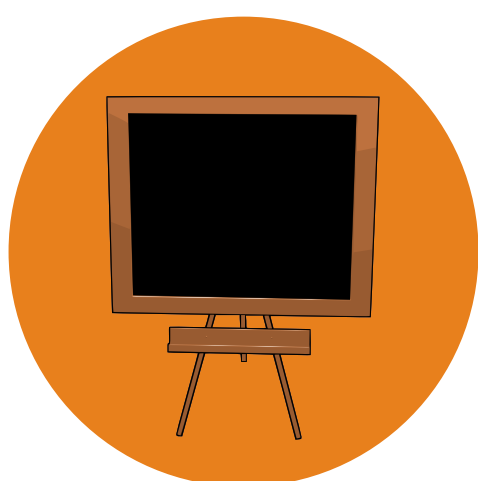


Professional Development Workshops for New Career-Technical Education Teachers
