Achieving academic excellence may require that the Family and Consumer Science teacher work collaboratively with other members of the school staff and with parents.

- Ability to work collaboratively with teachers, support personnel, staff from partner schools, and agency representatives

- The successful applicant must possess the ability to continually develop the program by consulting with business and industry.
- The instructor must have the ability to develop relationships with industry, to secure industry related resources, and to organize / participate with an industry specific advisory council.
