



REGIONAL CAREER DEVELOPMENT EVENT FAQ

1. Where do I find the CDE Rules and Rubrics?

Go to the affiliation portal under Resources click on Ohio Virtual CDE's.

2. What is the difference between Ohio Virtual CDE's and National Star Events?

The content and topics are the same, however the rules and rubrics format is different.

3. What type of platform/ source can I use for presentation, display and/or portfolio?

Video presentations, electronic portfolios, and/or electronic display can use any platform/source that can be converted into a PDF format with an URL.

4. Where do I upload the URL?

Members and/or advisers can upload the URL to the [DLG](#)

5. What happens if a member uploads a URL to DLG?

Advisers must approve all URL submissions before an evaluation can take place.

6. Once the URL is uploaded participants can continue working on their project?

No once the URL is submitted the project is submitted.

7. Who takes the online test?

Anyone participating in a CDE whether individual or team must take the assigned test.

8. What is the content on the online test?

Each test is made up with content specific and FCCLA general information of 20 true/false and multiple-choice questions.

9. Is the Online Test the same for all participants?

The Online Tests in Ohio have been divided into 5 categories and assigned to specific CDE's. The categories are Business Foundation, Design, Education and Training, General Careers and Hospitality and Tourism.

10. Where does the test scores come into play with the CDE evaluation?

Each participant score will be added to the Point Summary sheet and averaged if a team. The test counts as 20 points towards the final score.

11. How does a team event video member?

It will be a local decision based on the district's delivery model. Points will not be deducted if the video is spliced together.

12. Will the quality of the video be evaluated?

Evaluators will be asked not to focus on the quality of the video but the quality of the project. There is no place on the rubric to evaluate the video quality.

13. For the Culinary Team does the team prepare an omelet, hollandaise sauce and break down a chicken along with the state menu?

This year Culinary Team will only prepare a 3-egg omelet, Hollandaise Sauce (recipe provided) and break down a chicken, there will be no menu.

14. Will participants/advisers receive rubrics?

Yes, after the scores are validated approximately one-week later advisers will have access to the rubrics to show with students.

15. Will participants be recognized?

Yes, each region will have an Award Session released on March 7 at 7:30 pm through Facebook and the Ohio FCCLA website.

16. Will participants receive medals?

Yes, rating medals and seals will be sent to the school after regionals are completed.
