# July 2020 OSL Council Meeting Minutes

The July 21, 2020 OSL Council meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Council President Travis Hanel. Pastor Janet opened with devotion and prayers.

Attending: Amanda Liebersbach, Pastor Janet, Jim Duckstad, Kaitlin Barbosa, Travis Hanel, Tony Johnson. Absent: Adam Sparby

Approval of Agenda and Previous Meeting
Minutes: Tony made a motion to approve
the agenda and previous meeting
minutes. Jim seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Amanda presented the financials for May and June. Insurance was paid in full for the year. General fund is doing well with no concerns. Jim made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. Tony seconded. Motion carried.

Pastor Janet's Report: Visitation has been completed by phone, cards, email or text, but Pastor Janet will now begin some visitation in person. There are two upcoming weddings: one outdoors and one planned within our sanctuary. Travis made a motion for upcoming services to adhere to Minnesota Department of Health, CDC Guidelines and synod recommendations for church gatherings to be no more than 100 people in our sanctuary, which is 50% of the fire code capacity and for adhering to social distancing and required mask wearing. Jim seconded. Motion carried.

There was one funeral, two baptisms and there are two upcoming baptisms. Pastor Janet has been doing outreach in the community through the Warren Sheaf, Food Shelf, Warren Ministerial and nursing home. Confirmation is planned to start in the fall.

Sunday morning worship continues by video on Sunday morning and shared through Facebook, Channel 13, YouTube and the church website. We continue to pray for the world around us and give thanks for the financial gifts that are greatly appreciated.

With Pastor Ron's passing, Pastor Janet would like to continue his ministry and visitation by taking over his position.

Tony made a motion for Pastor Janet to take on the additional responsibilities and pay of Pastor Ron, with a monthly update provided by Pastor Janet. Jim seconded. Motion carried.

Jim made a motion to approve the pastor's report. Tony seconded. Motion carried.

#### Committee Reports:

Stewardship: No report.

Worship & Evangelism: Worship calendar set for August. Online services are well-received.

Education & Youth: They have met and will hold off on summer programming and VBS.

Property & Management: Mowing of church and parsonage continues. Jake has been doing deep cleaning while the church has been closed. Office has been staffed by Joan, Pastor Janet and Wanda. Tony made a motion to approve the committee reports. Kaitlin seconded. Motion carried.

#### Old Business

The organist vacancy was discussed. Pastor Janet has a back-up if needed.

Secretary/Office Mgr. Vacancy: Wanda will continue to fill-in as needed until August 31 following her retirement in July. Several people have been approached but we will continue to look and start advertising.

Computer needs: A new computer and printer will be purchased for the youth director. Projection Unit is on hold.

Basement Tables & Chairs: A committee has formed and is looking at options.

#### **New Business**

In-Person Worship: Return to in-person worship was discussed. Travis made a motion to begin in-person worship on August 16 with mandatory masks, social distancing and at 50% capacity. Jim seconded. Motion carried.

The next meeting of the OSL council will be on Tuesday, August 18 at 7:00 p.m. Jim made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 p.m. Tony seconded. Motion carried.

For Preparation for Holy Communion: A home packet will also be available.


Thank you to all for social distancing and masking up for committee meetings and councils.
