

September 2020 OSL Council Meeting Minutes

Our Savior's Lutheran Church Council Minutes

The September 15, 2020 OSL Council meeting was called to order at 7:06 p.m. by Council President Travis Hanel. Pastor Janet opened with devotion and prayer.

Attending: Kaitlin Barbosa, Travis Hanel, Jim Duckstad, Tony Johnson, Joan Peterson, Pr. Janet.

Absent: Adam Sparby.

Youth Report: Joan presented the youth director board report. Youth committee met last night. They will hold a Papa Murphy's fundraiser in the upcoming weeks to raise funds for the National Youth Gathering in 2022. They are discussing other fundraising options. Joan is preparing a letter to inform families of the National Youth Gathering and upcoming events. They are also planning a bonfire with s'more and hot dog roasting. Youth leadership Sunday will move to the second Sunday rather than the fourth Sunday.

Approval of Agenda and Previous Meeting Minutes: There was an addition to New Business to discuss visitation pastor salary. Jim moved to approve the agenda with additions and the previous meeting minutes and Kaitlin seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report: FICA was paid, but most expenses were standard. Income was ahead in June and July, but we are now slightly behind for the month of August. However, general fund looks good overall. Tony motions to approve the treasurer's report. Jim seconds. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report: This is a busy time of year with Rally Day. Pastor Janet has completed nine in-home visits. Apartment visits are difficult at this time, but has followed up with others by phone, text, cards or emails. There were two weddings, two funerals, one committal and four baptisms.

WELCA did not meet this month but will not be doing the Fall supper.
Men's Bible Study will begin on September 23. Confirmation is planned.
A new Tech Committee has formed:

Josh and Katie Benson, Jim Duckstad, Adam Sparby, Brian Wurtzel, Mike Miller. This committee will work on recording, sound and projection needs within the congregation. A COVID response team has also formed: Sharon Nelson, Heather Goroski, Phil Thompson, Joan Peterson. This committee will consider needs of the church during COVID.

The upcoming worship schedule has been planned through October with blessings of backpack on September 20, bibles and stoles presented on October 11, and Confirmation Sunday on October 25.

Jim moved to approve Pastor's report. Kaitlin seconded. Motion carried.

Committee Reports

Stewardship: Blessing of the Harvest is planned for October 4, food shelf is staffed in September, and still considering pictorial directory.

Worship & Evangelism: Hymns are planned through the end of October and altar guild is set. Joan is looking into additional music for services. New liturgy will begin on Confirmation Sunday. Jeanie Ulferts submitted her resignation from the Narthex Committee which was accepted with great appreciation for her service.

Education and Youth: Rally
Day is set for September 20.
All classes are covered for
teachers and has a substitute
list. 10th Grade Confirmation
will meet October 4. 9th
Grade Confirmation begins
September 20. 7th and 8th
Grade Confirmation will
begin on September 30 with
orientation and acolyte training.

Property: Mowing is wrapping up. A tree is to be removed at parsonage and ballasts to be replaced in offices and kitchenette. The paving circle has been completed by Jakob

Wurtzel's Eagle Scout Project in front of the church. A cross will be displayed on the pavers.

Tony moved to approve committee reports. Kaitlin seconded. Motion carried.

Old business:

Office Manager position: Reviewed applications and formed interview committee.

Technology/Computer Needs: Looking at cordless mic for Pastor Janet

Landscape/Cross Installation:
Jakob Wurtzel for his Eagle
Scout project installed pavers
and will add a cross later.

New Business

Fall Focus: Two new committees formed for technology and COVID response.

Channel 13: We would like to have worship livestreamed onto Channel 13 at 10:45 a.m., but our technology cannot accommodate livestreaming. The service will be played on Sundays and Mondays at 3:30 p.m.

Quilting: Quilters will begin on October 6 with social distancing and masks.

Visitation Pastor: Council followed up with Pr. Janet about the visitation needs and the pay raise for the additional responsibilities of visitation through the end of the year. This will be reviewed as part of the budgeting process for the 2021 budget year and compared to synod guidelines for her total salary.

Kaitlin moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:45 p.m. Jim seconded. Motion carried. The next meeting of the OSL Council will meet on Tuesday, October 27 at 7:00 p.m.


