

From the Pastor's Desk

"You must love the Lord God with all your heart, all your passion, all your energy, and your every thought. And you must love your neighbor as yourself."

(Luke 10:27, The Passion Translation)

I love the way that different Bible translations can take familiar scriptures and make them sound new and alive to us. Take the above example. The translation we're accustomed to hearing says, "You are to love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength, and your neighbor as yourself." But *The Passion Translation* introduces loving the Lord with "all your passion, all your energy, and your every thought." This taps into a different part of us, I think, giving us new words for how we can love the Lord fully, with all that we have and all that we are.

I am grateful for those who have the skill to sit with the original languages of the texts and give us fresh ways to encounter and embrace them. Many translations can be encountered simply by going online or using a Bible app on your phone. My favorite sources to use are BibleGateway and YouVersion, in case you want to do some comparing on your own to encounter God's word anew.

Yet, even if we were to not have access to these different translations, there is another way to hear the word of God in new ways: by tapping into our own unique experiences. Consider, how can I restate a passage of scripture using my own words? Or, from what I have come to know of God, what more can I add to what is being spoken? By doing this, we are able to allow the scripture to speak directly to and through our lives, in ways that are deeply personal and impacting. This is important because the scriptures are meant for this very purpose, for God to be able to reach and speak to our lives through them.

As the summer continues on, let's give ourselves space to enter God's word and see how it speaks to and through us in fresh ways.


