### December 15, 2020

The December 15, 2020 OSL Council meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by Council President Travis Hanel. Pastor Janet opened with devotions and prayer.

**Attending:** Tony Johnson, Travis Hanel, Kaitlin Barbosa, Adam Sparby, Jim Duckstad, and Pastor Janet.

The meeting began with discussion on location of projection screen and location of computer to control projection. More information is needed for cost on running cables to the back of the church.

Approval of Agenda and Previous Meeting Minutes: Adam motioned to approve the agenda and previous meeting minutes. Kaitlin seconded. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Pr. Janet reported that expenses were normal for November with faithful offerings. General fund is doing well. Jim motioned to approve the treasurer's report. Tony seconded. Motion carried.

**Pastor's Report:** Pastor Janet is busy with worship prep and calling homebound and other visitation completed by cards, texts or email. Extension of the table was sent to over 40 people. She is completing a few home visits as requested. The pandemic is causing stress for many families and Pr. Janet is supporting them. There were no funerals or baptisms in November. No upcoming winter weddings.

Youth have completed blessings bags to be given to others as a blessing. Sharing tree is complete and gifts are being purchased. Sunday School participants came individually to record pieces of the Christmas program and will be shown on Sunday for Christmas program. Confirmation is done by Zoom and inperson depending on grade. The Tech Committee met and is working on projection and virtual services.

Virtual Christmas Eve candlelight worship is planned and being recorded. January 3rd vacation was requested for Joan and will be covered by Linda. Pr. Janet has requested this Sunday as well.

Adam motioned to approve the Pastor's Report. Tony seconded. Motion carried.

### Committee Reports:

**Stewardship:** Sharing tree is completed and gifts being purchased.

Worship & Evangelism: Worship calendar is set for hymns.

There will be a Virtual Christmas Eve service on channel 13 at 4:30 p.m., 10 p.m. and replayed again on Christmas Day at 10:45 a.m. A live nativity will be in front of the church at 4:15 p.m. on Christmas Eve with passing out of blessing boxes.

**Education and Youth:** Virtual Sunday school program will be on Sunday, December 20 as part of the carol service. Jim motioned to keep services virtual through the end of January, with drop-ins welcome. Tony seconded. Motion carried.

**Property & Management:** Tech Committee met. Conversation about location of AV control. Light is getting checked in the basement, three-way switch is getting checked in library, and considering changing all lights in basement and secretary office. Tree removal at parsonage this winter.

Jim motioned to approve the committee reports. Adam seconded. Motion carried.

#### **Old Business**

Council Members: Kaitlin's term is up in 2021 and will be done. Tony will serve another term as his term is also up in 2021. At least one more member will need to be recruited.

### **New Business**

Mallory will continue as secretary and will also be taking over financial secretary and power points. With additional responsibilities, Travis motioned to move her position to \$18 an hour at 30 hours a week starting January 2. Jim seconded. Motion carried.

Christmas bonuses were given up to a total of \$800.

The next meeting will be on January 12 at 7:00 p.m. Kaitlin motions to adjourn meeting. Adam seconded. Motion carried.


