## FIRST DAY CHECKLIST

- Sunscreen & applied to child before school (labelled stick sunscreen provided for reapplication)
- Spare clothing  
Large ziplock bag of seasonally appropriate clothes (school uniform or school colours).  
Extra sets of socks and underwear are always ideal (labelled & left at school)
- Indoor shoes with a closed back and closed toe (labelled & left at school)  
Please provide shoes that are easy for children to change in and out of to promote independence.



- Daily Snacks & Lunch  
Please note, the classrooms do not have microwaves and or supply cutlery.  
We are a nut-free school so please label lunches that have alternative peanut butter sandwiches for clarification. See Preschool Parent Handbook for healthy lunch ideas.
- Water Bottle
- Sheet & small blanket in a sealed ziplock bag

Parents are asked to fill out a Medical Alert form if their child has any type of allergy.

If your child has anaphylaxis, we require 2 updated epi-pens along with the Emergency Medical Form, These must be in your child's homeroom class at drop-off on the first day.
