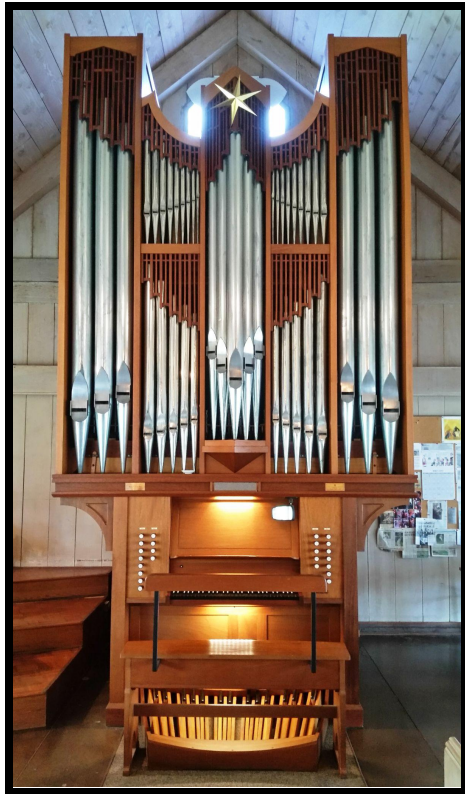

Gail Archer is an international concert organist, recording artist, choral conductor and lecturer who draws attention to composer anniversaries or musical themes with her annual recital series in New York City, including *A Slavic Celebration*, Max Reger, *The Muse's Voice*, *An American Idyll*, Liszt, Bach, Mendelssohn and Messiaen. Ms. Archer was the first American woman to play the complete works of Olivier Messiaen for the centennial of the composer's birth in 2008: *Time Out* New York recognized the Messiaen cycle as "Best of 2008" in classical music and opera. Her recordings include her 2022 Polish release, *Cantius*, and *Chernivtsi, A Russian Journey*, *The Muse's Voice*, *Franz Liszt: A Hungarian Rhapsody*, *Bach: The Transcendent Genius*, *an American Idyll*, *A Mystic in the Making* (Meyer Media), and *The Orpheus of Amsterdam: Sweelinck and his Pupils* (CALA Records). Ms. Archer's 2023 European tour took her to Italy, France, Austria, Germany and Poland. Highlights include St. Cyriakus R. C. Church, Krefeld, Germany, Basilica Cattedrale di Santa Maria Assunta, Messina, Sicily, the Cathedral of Santa Maria, Alghero, Sardegna, the Church of Saint Bruno Les Chartreux, Lyon, France, and the Church of St. Vitali, Ravenna, Italy, a UNESCO World Heritage site, with its extraordinary mosaics.

She is the founder of Musforum, www.musforum.org an international network for women organists to promote and affirm their work. Ms. Archer is college organist at Vassar College, director of the music program at Barnard College, Columbia University, where she conducts the Barnard-Columbia Chorus and Chamber Singers and a faculty member of the Harriman Institute, Columbia University. She is artistic director of the artist and young artist recital series at historic Central Synagogue, New York City.



The magnificent organ at **St. Christopher's Episcopal Church in Kailua** is a two-manual, 20-stop, mechanical-action pipe organ crafted by **J. W. Walker & Sons, Ltd.** of England and installed in this Church in 1983. It possesses a warm, distinctive and noble singing quality ideally suited for service music, choral accompaniment, and a wide range of organ literature. It has been described as among the three best organs in Hawai'i and certainly the best organ on the Windward side of Oahu.

A tracker organ, it is distinguished from other pipe organs by its mechanical action. The links between the keys/stop actions and the pipes are direct and purely mechanical rather than electrical. As a result, the artist can completely control the speech and articulation of each pipe in a manner similar to

the playing of a piano or harpsichord.

The Walker organ has two 61-note keyboards and a 32-note pedalboard. In the tradition of classic English organs, the keyboard naturals are made of black ebony with the sharps capped in white bone. The precision-crafted organ mechanism is enclosed in a 16-foot, free-standing case of African mahogany.

The façade pipes will have to be replaced soon, because they are bent. We are hoping that you can help by making a donation to our organ fund.
