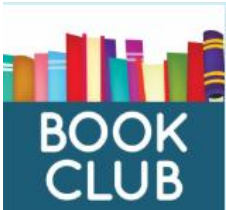

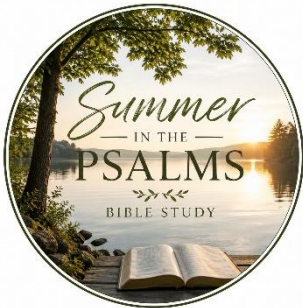
Altar flowers are donated by the Miller family in honor of Holden's confirmation.
