HOLY WEEK CALENDAR



PALM SUNDAY 10:00am: We enter this holy week accompanying Jesus to the cross with both grief and thanksgiving in our hearts, trusting in God's redeeming love.

THE "TRIDUUM" (Latin for "three days") refers to the three three-day period of religious observance



MAUNDY THURSDAY 7:30pm: from the Latin "mandatum;" it is from a verb that means "to command." The Last Supper, Foot washing, and the Stripping of the altar are observed.



GOOD FRIDAY AT NOON: Marks the beginning of the "tre ore", the three hours Jesus was on the cross, the seven last words of Jesus, holy oil, and the veneration of the cross is observed.

7:30pm: Tenebrae (Latin for "shadows" or "darkness") includes the gradual dimming of the lights and extinguishing of candles. The Christ candle is removed from the sanctuary and a concluding "Strepitus" or loud noise symbolizes the earthquake and agony of creation at the death of Christ.



VIGIL OF EASTER: 7:00pm at Calvary Lutheran. 860 Townline Road Hauppauge, NY 11788 The Easter Vigil is the pinnacle of the church year; it is the first celebration of Easter (traditionally, holy days are considered to begin at sunset).



EASTER SUNDAY 10:00am: Let us rejoice: Christ is risen indeed! Alleluia!
