St. Andrew's is partnering with the Smithtown Emergency Food Pantry to provide local families with a complete Thanksgiving dinner. You can help by "adopting a family" and filling a pantry-provided box with all the fixings for a traditional holiday meal.

The Pantry will supply the turkey — we're asking parishioners to fill the box with:

- 4 cans vegetables
- 2 cans cranberry sauce
- 1 large can yams (or 2 small)
- 1 juice (64 oz) or juice boxes
- Cake, brownie, or cookie mix
- 1 box instant potatoes
- 2 boxes Stove Top stuffing
- 3 cans fruit
- 2 turkey gravy
- Muffin mix

Please include a few "extras" such as candy, hot chocolate, marshmallows, cookies, icing, applesauce, or shelf-stable milk.

No fresh fruit or vegetables. Feel free to decorate your box and include a prayer or note of encouragement.

Boxes will be available in the church narthex and are due back to the church or directly to the Food Pantry by Tuesday, November 18.

Please use packing tape on the bottom of the box to keep it sturdy.


