Collectively, with your voice and lobbying from California Arts Advocates, California Association of Museums, and CalNonprofits, we advocated to the state for funding specifically for our sector, and on Feb 23 [SB 87](#) was signed into law, **approving \$50 million in funding for nonprofit cultural institutions. Round 4 of the [California Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant Program, The Arts & Cultural Program](#), will support California eligible cultural institutions defined as registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit entities. Unlike previous rounds, **there is no limitation to apply based on annual gross revenue.**
