TALK ABOUT IT

Family Conversations

- 1 Sheep liked to obey the shepherd and stick with the other sheep. What are some ways that you obey your parents? Your teachers?
- 2 Goats didn't like to follow a shepherd—they tended to run away on their own and get lost. How does independence work for and against us? For and against the community of God's people?
- 3 Why would Jesus choose to hang around people who smelled and messed up and needed help? How has Jesus' love changed us?
- 4 If we followed Jesus, where would he lead us? Give each family member a footprint cut out of paper to use as they imagine and demonstrate their answer to this question.



Eye Spark

Place an empty bowl in the refrigerator to remind one another that there are hungry people who need our love and offerings.



Ear Spark

Practice standing in a circle making sheep sounds (baaaaaaaaaaaaas) and goat sounds (maaaaaaaaaaaaaaaaas). Place a blindfolded shepherd in the middle of the circle, and challenge him or her to separate the sheep from the goats.

LIVE IT

For families to do together

Call your church office to ask about a church family or shut-in who could use a meal. People with new babies love to get a meal! Prepare and deliver the meal together.

For younger kids

Jesus wants us to follow his example. Play a game of Follow the Leader and pretend you're following Jesus. Where does Jesus go?

For older kids

Use an online search engine to learn more about your national church and how people just like you are working with God's people around the globe. Use Google Earth to zoom in on some of the countries where missionaries serve "the least of these."
