**WSA-OC Cal20 Regatta
Long Beach, CA
Saturday, September 9th, 2017**

NOTICE OF RACE

WSA-OC is pleased to organize and manage for its members, the WSA-OC Cal20 Regatta to be held in Long Beach Harbor. While all members are welcome and encouraged to participate, the event is being held to help introduce 'new to racing' members to the excitement of sailboat racing. If you have previously participated in the WSA-OC Regatta 101 events held in Dana Point, this represents a next logical step in learning more about sailboat racing and providing an opportunity to receive training on being a skipper. The Cal20 sailboats that will be used, are provided to us by the SYC Sailing Foundation in Long Beach, CA. Due to the size of the boats, crew and skipper will be limited to 3 persons per boat, therefore, participation will be limited. A cancellation/waitlist will also be created. This is not intended to be a formal regatta as defined by the rules of PHRF of Southern California, or any other organization, and all participants do so at their own risk.

1. Eligibility and Entry

The event is open to all current WSA-OC members.

The fee is \$25.00 for each participant. Entry may be made online at the WSA-OC website and payment made at the time of registration.

1.1. Entry and registration must be received no later than Sept 1st, 2017.

2. Crew Assignment

2.1. The vessel skipper must be certified on a Cal20 by a representative(s) of the SYC Sailing Foundation. The members registering that also request to be certified, will be contacted for training and/or certification/approval. The crew members will be assigned on a random basis to each boat. The total number of crew on any given vessel will not exceed the maximum that the vessel is safely designed to carry or as determined by the SYC Sailing Foundation.

3. On-The-Water Race Schedules

3.1. Two races shall be held within the Long Beach breakwater and the courses will be announced prior to each race. Course charts will be provided to each skipper.

3.2. The first warning signal to begin shall be at 11:00 A.M. with on-the-water activity to end by 5:00 P.M.

4. Handicaps / Race Results

4.1. Race scores for each race shall be in order of actual finish (1 for first, 2 for second, etc.). Overall winners for the regatta will be based upon the total score of the two races. In the event of ties, the total elapsed time for the two races shall be used for the tie break.

5. Trophies

5.1. Subject to the number of participants, there will be one or more trophies and shall be awarded on the final race results.

6. Disclaimer of Liability

6.1. Participants do so entirely at their own risk. Neither WSA-OC, the SYC Sailing Foundation or Shoreline Yacht Club, will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during, or after the event.

7. Skipper Meeting and Hospitality

7.1. Skippers and all participants shall meet at 9:00 A.M. at Shoreline Yacht Club for sailing instructions and event updates.

7.2. Trophy presentation and post-race question and answer discussion, with food provided and a no-host bar, will begin at 5:00 P.M. at Shoreline Yacht Club.
