What is Summer Camp?

Summer Camp is a fun match racing clinic where one can learn about 3 different areas of match racing – sailing, race management and umpiring.

How does Summer Camp work?

Choose your area of interest, sign up, and come join us for a weekend of learning and meeting others interested in match racing. We will supply the boats, lots of instruction, food & drink, and ... entertainment!



Specifics:

June 8 – 10th. June 8th is structured practice to help everyone hone their boat handling day for Competitors. Classes begin Friday evening for everyone else, racing and on the water classes to take place June 9th and 10th. All events will take place off the long dock – which will be filled with snacks, drinks, music, camaraderie and all around Summer Camp Fun! Summer Camp also includes dinner and entertainment each night poolside with fire pits, swimming, and games. Cost is \$85 per participant, + \$150 charter fee for competitor skippers.

Match Race Competitor – open to any all female crews with enough experience want to spend the weekend competing. Bring your crew of 3 or 4 to compete in the weekend Summer Camp regatta. Regatta will be sailed on Solings and a new trophy will be on the table to win, please see NOR for skipper eligibility details.

Match Race Student – open to any females, of any age, with sailing knowledge. Bring a crew or we will assign you to a crew. Spend the weekend in class on and off the water learning about match racing. On the water leaning will be in Solings.

Race Committee Student – open to all genders and ages. Sign up to learn all about how to put on a Match Racing event. Participants will learn how to structure a club event, how to set a course, and how to perform the start, finish and scoring of a match race event.

Umpiring Student – open to all genders and ages. Sign up to learn about on the water Umpiring. Participants will receive classroom and on the water experience in Umpiring a club match racing event. Knowledge of the rules would be helpful in this category.

Note: No certifications will be obtained for Race Management or Umpiring at Summer Camp – after all - *it's not summer school!* Our goal is to send you home with enough knowledge to put on an event to get your own club sailors out on a weeknight or weekend and get some match racing practice in!!
