Bilge & Pumps

Check bilge water level
Is auto bilge pump operational?

Engine & Electrical

- Check engine oil level
- Check alternator belt 1/2" deflection
- Check seawater strainer for debris, clean if necessary
- Check battery voltage 1 / 2
- Turn battery selector to BOTH
- Turn on instruments
- Turn VHF radio on ch. 16

Galley, Salon, Aft Head

Dishes cleaned and stowed
Personal gear stowed
Galley sink drain closed
Aft head sea water inlet closed
Aft head vanity sink drain closed
Dog all hatches

When under sail

Transmission in reverse
Switch battery selector to 1 (House)

At Anchor or Moored

- Snubber on bow anchor
- Quick release for mooring (if applicable)
- Cockpit and deck wash down
- Open galley sink drain
- Open up aft head sea water inlet
- Switch battery selector to 1
- Anchor light on at sunset
- Charge batteries if at 12.2V (1500 RPM, 2 Hrs)
- Refrigerator off overnight
