When I was seven years old, my mom told me to get out of the car at the next stop because my dad was drunk and angry. My mother and I walked in the rain to Esperanza Shelter with nothing but the clothes on our backs and found a safe place to live and heal. We stayed in room eight at Esperanza's emergency shelter for two months. The time we spent at the shelter saved our lives, provided us hope, and helped influence my life's mission of supporting others who have been affected by domestic abuse.

I recently toured the shelter site with my mom and we both agreed that the building is in need of repair. **It still looked the same from our time in shelter 26 years ago.**
