**Directions to Games, All Games at St. Paul's**

*To St. Paul's from City Tree (Pacific Beach Area)*

Turn left on Elm Street, 5 north to Grand/Garnet exit. Stay in left-hand lane to Grand Avenue, turn left. Grand to Fanuel Street and turn right. Fanuel to Felspar and turn right. St. Paul's will be on your left-hand side. 1376 Felspar Street, 858-272-6282.

# Basketball Game Rules

## Home Team

- First team listed on the schedule is the home team. Home team bench is closest to the gym door.

## Game Length and Clock

- 8-minute running clock quarters—4 quarter games
- STOP CLOCK only during the LAST TWO minutes of the 2nd and 4th quarters (waived if the point differential is more than 15 points).
- 3-minute halftime

## Clock and Scoreboard

- If a team is ahead by more than 25 points, the score board will not show more points for that team, but the points will be scored in the scorebook.
- Running clock with the following exceptions:
  - During time outs
  - The last two minutes of each half (waived for the last two minutes of the game if the point differential is more than 15 points)
  - While teams line up for free throws

## Overtime

- 3-minute overtime with one 30 second timeout per team.
- First minute of overtime is running clock.
- One overtime will be played. If the game is still a tie after the first overtime, it remains a tie.

## Time Outs

- Three times out per team, per game and time outs are 30 seconds in length

## Bonus and Double Bonus

- Seven team fouls = bonus (1 and 1)
- Ten team fouls = double bonus (2 free throws)

## Three Point Shot

- Outside the red (volleyball) lines

## Full Court Press and Backcourt

- 10 second backcourt rules are in effect.
- A Division teams may press at any time.
- NO BACKCOURT pressure by the team leading if the point differential is more than 15 points
- Full court press is limited for B Division teams to the last two minutes of each quarter.

## B Division Free Throws

- Players are allowed to step over the free throw line, and the free throw will count, as long as the shooter starts behind the line and does not attempt a rebound until the ball hits the rim.
