## **Two Tax Advantages for Charitable Donations in 2020:**

Recognizing that non-profits (like City Tree) struggle in times of economic uncertainty, Congress passed new laws to encourage individuals and corporations to make charitable donations in 2020. Thus, if you make a donation to City Tree in 2020, you may be able to take advantage of recently passed tax legislation regarding charitable donations.

- 1. The deduction for charitable contributions by individuals/corporations who itemize their expenses on their tax return has been increased, meaning you can take a greater deduction for your charitable deduction against your income. (For individuals, you can deduct the entire 100% donation if it is in cash. For corporations, the limitation was increased from 10% to 25% for both cash and contributions of food inventory donations.)
- 2. Whether or not you itemize your deductions on your tax return, Congress has allowed (just for cash donations made in 2020) a \$300 above the line deduction against your income.
