FREE DRESS DAY

A free dress day occurs on the last Thursday (school day) of each month for all students who have retained free dress privileges for that month. Students are not required to wear uniforms on this day and may wear appropriate clothing of their choice within the following guidelines:

- Shoes meet the uniform code, no sandals, high heels, or sharp-toed boots.
- 2. Skirt/short length must be long enough to allow for activity while being appropriately modest—no more than 3 inches above the top of the knee. Skirts may not be rolled at the waist in order to circumvent the length requirement.
- T-shirts may not depict anything involving drugs or alcohol, or contain violent or sexual connotations.
- Clothing in good repair without holes or stains.
- No bare midriffs, spaghetti straps, strapless, or halter-tops allowed.No skin between the pants and shirt may show.
- 6. All clothing should allow for normal movement in an active school day.
- 7. All previously mentioned guidelines regarding makeup, hair, hats, and fingernails apply on this day as well.
