We ask all parents to make sure their child has extra clothing in their cubby (2x underwear, socks, shoes, t-shirt and shorts).
- Make sure all your child's items (clothing, bag, towel, shoes, lunchbox, etc) are LABELED.
- Please bring in a cold lunch, or if they bring something in that need to be warmed up, please warm up the lunch item at home (make it hot) and place it in a thermos. There are no emergency lunches or hot lunch provider over the summer months.
- During the summer we may have surprise patio picnics and will have lunch on the patio playground for the class assigned water play day.
