

Financial firm buys office in city

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HIGH POINT — A High Point wealth management firm has purchased a downtown office building and is moving its practice there.

Matt Thiel, president of Signature Wealth Strategies, said he expects to move into

High Point,” Thiel said. “It aligns with our vision of being fully invested in the local community.”
