The Arts Council will present *Dancin' & Shaggin'* at the Station with special guest Envision on Friday, July 16, from 7 to 10 p.m. at the Centennial Station Arts

Center, 121 S. Centennial St.

Envision delivers a high-energy stage show complete with professional choreography, tight musicianship, smooth harmonies and powerhouse lead vocals. Although specializing as a "party band," the band's repertoire encompasses a variety of musical styles, including R&B, beach, Motown/oldies, pop, dance, funk and jazz.

Envision has performed as an opening act for several national artists, ranging from actress and American Idol alum Jordin Sparks and The S.O.S. Band to R&B sensations Kem and Marsha Ambrosius.

Due to COVID-19, the event will be a hybrid performance with only 150 patrons in attendance and unlimited livestream viewership. There will be no mask requirement for attend-

ees who are fully vaccinated. The dance floor and bar will be open, along with a food truck on site.
