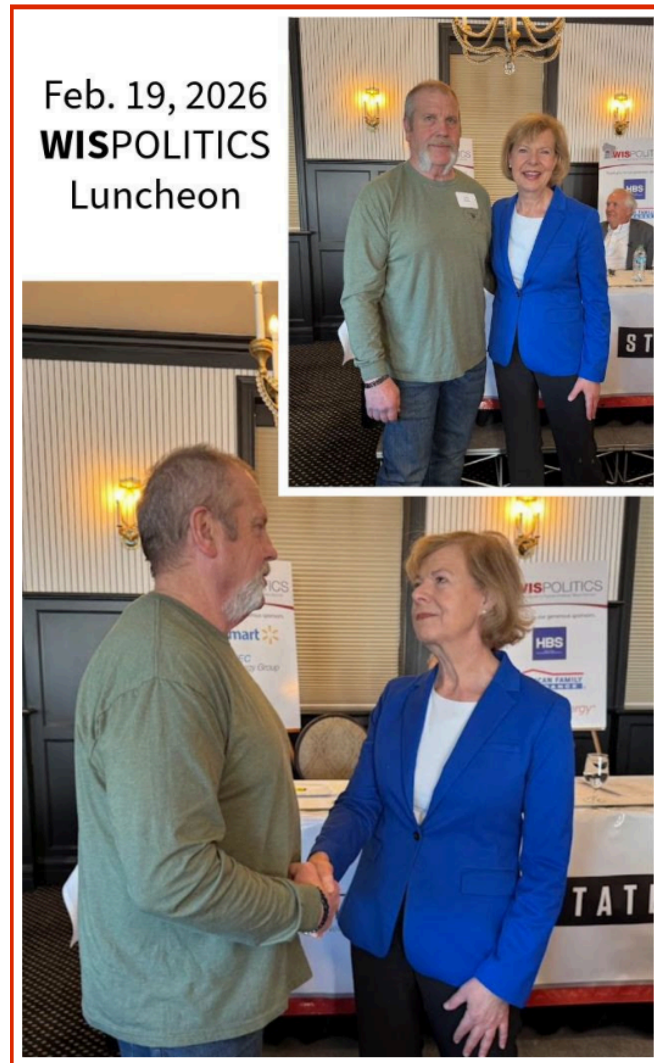


**We Are The Motorcycle Riders Foundation:**

# **Grassroots In Action**

## **Wisconsin Engaging Key Lawmakers**

**Last month, grassroots advocacy was on full display in Wisconsin. John Reblin, Executive Director of ABATE of Wisconsin, attended a political event featuring Tammy Baldwin (D-WI). Opportunities like this give motorcyclists a chance to engage directly with elected officials and ensure the concerns of riders remain part of the conversation.**

**Senator Baldwin is one of the 21 lawmakers the Motorcycle Riders Foundation has identified as key voices as Congress begins work on the next federal highway bill. These lawmakers will play an important role in shaping the policies that impact motorcyclists across the country, from roadway safety programs to infrastructure priorities.**

**Events like the one attended by Reblin demonstrate exactly why the MRF continues to be such a strong and effective voice in Washington, D.C. Our influence doesn't come from a single office or lobbyist it comes from riders across the country showing up and engaging with their elected officials.**

**The strength of the MRF is built on a powerful network: state motorcyclist rights organizations, dedicated club partners, strong relationships with the aftermarket industry, and thousands of individual riders who care about protecting motorcycling. When grassroots advocates connect with policymakers back home, it amplifies our message in the nation's capital.**

**The MRF encourages riders everywhere to follow Wisconsin's lead. Whether it's attending a town hall, meeting with a legislator at a local event, or simply introducing yourself as a concerned motorcyclist, these moments of engagement matter. They remind lawmakers that motorcyclists are paying attention and that we expect our voices to be heard when decisions are made about the future of America's roads.**
