Low-emission vehicle (LEV) standards

- Requirements that new engines in vehicles of all weight classes meet stronger emission standards.
- Reduced greenhouse gas, NOx, particulate matter, and other pollutant emissions.
- New vehicles that do not meet these requirements cannot be registered in Washington state.
- Used vehicle: 7,500 miles or more (trying to sell a bike with only 6000 miles?)
