Motorcycle Endorsement Scholarship is going ahead!

The Endorsement Scholarship Program Judy Mobray launched us on last fall is taking off.

Application and Information packets have gone out to the schools. Three young people have already shown interest. We even have our first completed application in hand. And as of yesterday's chapter meeting we are only \$87.00 away from covering the projected costs of the scholarships!

A few decisions worth noting were made at yesterday's meeting:

- We nominated Edie Smith, Sylus Damm, and Derek Binford as the selection committee that will choose our successful applicants.
- The age group for applicants has been expanded from 16 to 21 with the originally intended group from 16 to 18 taking precedent.
- Deadline for applications will be May 31, with successful applicants being contacted and announced the first week of June.

Application forms are included in this newsletter and as an attachment for printing. So if you know an aspiring young rider from 16 to 21 who lives in Grays Harbor and is a little short of the fees required to get an endorsement, print out an application and talk to them.

The DOL Motorcycle Safety Advisory Board statistic states that 75% of motorcycle related deaths involve untrained riders! We want to keep our young folks safe and build a program that grows into a Grays Harbor tradition.

Application for Grays Harbor Chapter of ABATE Motorcycle Endorsement Scholarship

The Grays Harbor Chapter of ABATE is offering 5 free Motorcycle Endorsement Scholarships to Grays Harbor residents between the ages of 16 and 18. These scholarships will cover the cost of enrollment in the motorcycle endorsement classes offered by WMST Driving School at their Aberdeen campus, and a one year membership in the Grays Harbor chapter of ABATE of Washington.

Experienced riders and members of the Grays Harbor chapter are also ready to mentor young riders during practice sessions before they have earned their endorsement in a safe and respectful environment, and on group rides once an endorsement has been earned.

Prerequisites:

- . Must be 16 to 18 years of age and a resident of Grays Harbor County.
- · Must have a valid Washington State Drivers License.
- Must have your parents or guardian's consent to take part in riding practice and enroll in endorsement classes.
- Must have basic protective equipment helmet, gloves, boots, and long sleeve coat and pants.
