RF works across the isle – Legislation works together to build relationships with COC and ABATE. MRF is on a lot of other boards and committees. MRF has national relationships with Harley-Davidson, Indian, Buell, other brands. Also, Cyclesource.

MRF A&E (Awareness & Education) committee spoke on their activities.

MRF Lobbyist – Rocky - MRF is good position at this time get priorities passed in the highway bill – items that come under the highway department. Last time Highway bill passed was when House/Senate/President are all the same party which was in 2021 everyone was Democrat. Now all three areas are Republican. Very good chance everything will pass.

The MAC (Motorcycle Advisory Council) was terminated this summer because the current administration clean house of all appointees from the prior president. Now Trump is reorganizing the MAC. MRF is working on getting the MRF seat back and having Jay Jackson, VP for MRF as our representative.

MRF board meeting closed now to vote and have private discussion not open to public.

All WA delegates went to register for conference, dinner and go to the Meet & Greet of all attendees. Then we went to hospitality room for food & refreshments.

Friday, Sept. 26th:

General Session – President Kirk, Hardtail presided.

Over 400+ people were present. Over 40+ states are present. 41 years MRF in existence.

Main focus is to "Educate, Motivate and Inspire" of Meeting of the Minds.

IN Washington D.C. there are 535 offices that make up the House and Senate. At Meeting on the Beltway <u>ALL</u> offices are seen in one day! "We are the heart of MRF and it is up to us."

- Right to repair or modify
- Vulnerable Roadway User Terminology

Need numbers, Need Young People, Need more State Motorcycle Rider Organizations (SMROs).

Highway Bill is renewed every 5 years. Under their jurisdiction is:

- Profiling
- Definition of a motorcycle
- Autonomous vehicles detect pedestrians, pets and bicycles. Looks at profile of object. Motorcycle is profile of bicycle but it goes too fast so eliminates as not really there. Electric bikes are part of going too fast and mopeds.
- The MAC Get MRF VP, Jay Jackson on the Board.

NHTSA lobby ban – They lobby in states against motorcyclists.

National COIR, (Council of Informed Rides) Please join Free. Help get information out. National COIR to register.

Continue to take the profiling survey every year. Congress wants numbers every year.

Treasurer Report:

- 42% of budget is membership dues
- 31% is donations
- 16% Admin costs

One year of Expenses in the bank. Working on getting three years of expenses in the bank. Transparency.

MRF A&E report and awards/scholarships.

Jay Jackson VP MRF, Safety, Safety Trainings Courses. In 2023 there were 6335 deaths on motorcycles. Every year it goes up. Motorcycles are 3% of Traffic and 15% of the fatalities. *The thought out there if eliminate motorcycles will eliminate 15% of deaths.*

MSF has a training coach shortage.

IMA (Independent Motorcycle Aftermarket) in existence 3 ½ years.

Industry is shrinking because being push out of business.
