The BOD voted to sponsor a full class for riders from ABATE this summer. I have received and forwarded bid from Cascade Motorcycle Safety for numerous different courses. Here is the option that we have chosen.

1. Cascade Gymkhana: At \$500/10 riders, this can possibly get 40 riders drilled over a weekend. The bang for the buck here is that there is no hard fast curriculum, but the drills can be tailored for the clientele. The bottom line, the rider improves their ability to put their front tire where that want it, and at the speed they want, with no drama.

The dates are for a morning and an afternoon session on Saturday 23 August and if there is a demand, we can add a morning and afternoon session on Sunday 24 August. If you are interested, message me and copy Jeff (Bubba), Bill, and your Chapter Coordinator. Let us know what you wish to practice. Improving your braking? Cornering vision? Linking corners? More technical corners, such as decreasing radius? (my favorite) Advanced cornering posture? Trail braking? We can tailor things to customer demand.

The details:

- 1. Rider Level: Novice through Expert
- 2. Event Length: 3 hours over one day
- 3. Location: Cascade Motorcycle Safety Anacortes
- 4. Participants: 10 riders, no passengers
- 5. Riding Gear: Full coverage (Jackets, good pants, DOT helmet, full fingered gloves, over the ankle footwear)
- 6. Motorcycle: Any street legal motorcycle, passing T-CLOCS, Liability Insurance

The training will be in the Anacortes area, and while that may seem to be a bit remote, it looks to me like a good excuse for a weekend getaway. This should fill up fast, so start thinking about why you wish to get some refresher training on the company dime. I will have had my new Tenere 700 for enough time that hopefully I can assist with the class.
