



Wyoming Women's Suffrage Pathway To Be Dedicated

UNVEILING EVENT: Media and the public are invited to join Wyoming Governor Matt Mead and Secretary of State Ed Buchanan for a historic event.

Location: Highway 28 – Mile Marker 44, Near South Pass City, WY

Wyoming Governor Matt Mead and Secretary of State Ed Buchanan will dedicate a 19 mile section of Highway 28 in Fremont County as the "Wyoming Women's Suffrage Pathway." The highway dedication follows the passage of Senate File 60 in the Wyoming Legislature's 2018 Budget Session which designated this section of Highway 28 in honor of legislation passed in 1869: "An act to grant the women of the Wyoming Territory the right of suffrage and to hold office."
