The City of El Segundo recognizes the vast amount of experience and skills that rest within the seniors of our city. Our Department desires to tap into these skills to help achieve Departmental goals in an effective and efficient manner. We also believe this to be an opportunity for seniors to give back to the community and provide needed services on a volunteer basis.

R.S.V.P.s assist both the Field Operations and Administrative Services Bureaus in their efforts to better serve the citizens of El Segundo.

Some of the R.S.V.P.s duties include: talking with local merchants, driving a marked volunteer car through the residential and commercial areas providing visibility, security and reporting criminal activity, checking homes while residents are on vacation, helping with traffic control, and other assigned duties.

To become an R.S.V.P., you must:

- Be age 55 and older
- Pass a background investigation
