Hands-On Shop Training

Put your knowledge into action with guided, real-world practice. Training includes proper Hunter alignment system compensation, caster measurement, and printout production. Participants will perform control arm adjustments for camber and caster, achieve a level steering wheel using WinToe, and explore common OE adjustment methods. Steering angle sensor resets using Hunter's CodeLink device (if available) will also be covered.
