



2017 CCIM Course Scholarship Program Information and Application

Scholarship Program Guidelines

The CCIM Foundation's CCIM Course Scholarship Program was created to support qualified real estate professionals in their efforts to achieve the CCIM designation. Recipient should exemplify the high caliber of professionals that comprise the CCIM Institute.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

Includes the following:

- Each applicant should be able to demonstrate a commitment to a commercial real estate career (see application).
- Each applicant should be able to demonstrate active involvement as a dues paying member with a local CCIM Chapter (see application).

For those seeking advanced course scholarships (CI 103 or CI 104) this additional criterion applies:

- Recipient of this scholarship should be selected from among individuals who have already successfully completed CI 101 and CI 102 and are currently Candidate Members of the CCIM Institute and have a need for financial assistance.

Scholarship Value

Recipient will receive a full tuition enrollment in **one** of the following CCIM designation courses: **CI 101, CI 102, CI 103 or CI 104.**

NOTE: Scholarship recipient will be responsible for reimbursing the Foundation for the full cost of a failed course; failing the course renders the scholarship null and void.

Procedure

Applications are submitted directly to the individual's local CCIM Chapter.

NOTE: The award certificate can only be redeemed for a 2017 course. The scholarship can not be applied retroactively to any course already taken; the award is not redeemable for cash; the CCIM Foundation will not reimburse individuals for any courses already taken.

Deadline for Submission to Chapters

November 1, 2016. The list of participating CCIM chapters can be found by going to our website at www.ccimef.org and clicking on "scholarships".

Recipient Notification

Email notification will be sent on or before December 15, 2016 to scholarship winners. Winners will receive a scholarship registration form for course registration. Recipient is responsible for submitting his/her scholarship course registration form to register for his/her course.
